8:00pm Return to the hotel for overnight

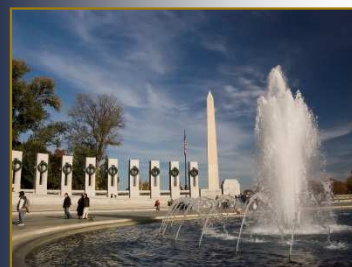

5:00pm Depart for home

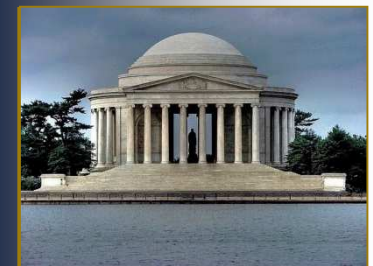
