2023 Middle School Summer Scholarship Application

The Central Music Boosters Summer Scholarship Program is offered to any current middle school student entering 6th-8th grade, who participates in band, choir, or performing art at Central Middle School or Prairie Knolls Middle School, or that is affiliated with Community Consolidated Unit School District 301. The scholarship will provide award funds for up to two students yearly. One to two students meeting the highest level of all required criteria for the scholarship will be considered for the program. The scholarship amount will be determined annually by the beginning of the school year, according to budgetary allocations. **During the 2022-2023 school year, a maximum of two, middle school scholarships shall be awarded in the amount of \$250 for each scholarship.**

When applying for a scholarship please **list the camp or activity** you wish to attend. If awarded, Central Music Boosters will write a check directly to the camp or activity you are interested in attending. There will be no awards made to individual students. The camp must be for vocal or instrumental music and director approved.
